

Thank you for your interest in our Summer Camp program! We offer summer camp care for children entering kindergarten through fifth grade. We have an exciting summer planned for our kids. They will be doing art and craft activities, playing games, watching movies, learning music, weekly bible lesson, and going on field trips. The information below contains the cost for our camp and other information that you need to know about our program.

- There is a \$50 non-refundable registration fee. This fee needs to be paid as soon as possible to guarantee a spot in our program. Children currently enrolled have first option to available spots. Once capacity is reached, your child will be placed on a waiting list. Please note last summer we had to turn children away.
- Our hours of operation are 7:00 am until 5:45 pm. If you are late picking up your child/children, each child's account will be charged a \$1 per minute late fee. After the fourth time you are late picking up your child/ children, the late fee goes to \$5 per minute per child for the duration of your child's attendance in our program.
- Tuition for <u>full week</u> campers is \$135 per week w/paid registration or \$150 per week without paid registration. Tuition includes field trips for the week and <u>must be paid</u> for the weeks you sign your child up for <u>regardless of</u> <u>attendance</u>. Tuition is due on Monday of the week your child attends. If tuition for the week is not received by 5:45 pm on Monday, a \$10 late fee will be applied to your child's account.

Tuition for **daily all day** campers is \$35 per day w/paid registration fee **plus** the cost of the field trip for the day or \$45 per day without paid registration **plus** the cost of the field trip for the day. Tuition for **daily part**time campers (4 hours or less) is \$25 per day with paid registration **plus** the cost of the field trip for the day or \$35 per day without paid registration **plus** the cost of the field trip for the day or \$35 per day without paid registration **plus** the cost of the field trip for the day or \$35 per day without paid registration **plus** the cost of the field trip for the day or \$35 per day without paid registration **plus** the cost of the field trip for the day. If you choose to pay daily or part time, tuition is due by 5:45 pm on the day your child attends. If tuition is not received by 5:45 pm of the day your child attends. a \$10 late fee will be applied to your child's account.

- We accept cash, check or money orders. Our program does not accept payments made by debit or credit cards but the Church does. If you would like to pay online by debit or credit you may do so by going to the Church website, <u>www.fbcmebane.com</u>, clicking on the give button and following the instructions. There is a drop down bar where you can select for the payment to come to SonShine Ministries. There is a fee associated with making payments online and you must choose to pay this fee when making your payment or it will be deducted from the payment amount made and you will still be responsible for that amount.
- If your child's account becomes more than a week behind, your child will be dismissed from the program until the account is current. Payments may be put in the payment drop box by the SonShine Ministries office or mailed to the address above. - ♥ If your check is returned by your bank, a \$35 returned check fee will be charged to your account. After 1 returned check, all fees must be paid by money order, certified bank check or cash.

- Children should wear weather appropriate clothing, including sunscreen. Weather permitting we are outside. No halter tops, tank tops with straps less than 1 1/2 inches wide, or any tops that only have strings to hold them on will be permitted. Short shorts are not appropriate and will not be permitted either.
- Bathing suits should fit appropriately. For girls this means one piece or tankinis and boys should wear swim trunks. No Speedo's will be allowed. Sunscreen should be applied before the child arrives on swimming day. Children will need a towel and a change of clothes, including underwear and socks, to change into after swimming.
- We provide a morning and afternoon snack only. We do not provide breakfast or lunch. A bag lunch and drink will need to be provided by you for your child every day. Please do not send in food that needs to be heated. If your child requires food that needs to be warm to eat, please cook it at home and put it into a thermos container. Please make sure your child has a water bottle labeled with their name. A sandwich, piece of fruit, raw vegetables and/or chips, along with a drink, are sufficient for most children.
- Electronics will only be allowed during summer camp at the Director's discretion. This includes phones, iPads, iPods, iWatchs, fitbits, hand held game systems, etc.
- We have blue rubber mulch on our playground and the color can get on shoes and clothing. Please send your child in clothes or shoes that you don't mind getting dirty. Your child will be playing on the playground every day weather permitting.
- If your child has diarrhea (2 or more loose bowel movements), vomiting or a fever, please do not bring him/her to school until he/she has gone 24 hours without a loose bowel movement, vomiting or has been fever free for 24 hours without the aid of medications. Example: If your child vomits on a Monday night at 7:00 pm, they can not return to summer camp until Wednesday morning. If a fever breaks during the night, the child <u>cannot</u> return to summer camp the next morning. This is to protect your child as well as the other children and staff members in our program. Remember, your child's tuition is still due regardless of attendance.
- Please notify us of any cases of infectious diseases such as COVID, strep, chicken pox, measles, mumps, impetigo, hepatitis, or meningitis, as well as head lice. You may need a doctor's note to return to summer camp.
- Please sign your child in and out each day. This is for safety purposes. If someone other than the regular pick-up person is coming for your child, please let us know when you drop off or by calling 919-563-3444 or 336-524-4576. We check I.D.s.
- We are required by North Carolina Law to report any suspected abuse to the North Carolina Department of Social Services.
